Jobs Fair: Wednesday 21 March 2018, 10 – 1 pm

The Scottish Government have approached Dundee City Council to host a Jobs Fair on the above date to launch the recruitment process of the Social Security Agency which will be based in the City. The event will take place in The Shore, 15 Shore Terrace.

The Civil Service announcement is expected to be the first phase of recruitment for customer service advisors there will be up to **750 job opportunities over the next two years**. They are keen to have opportunities for young people in their new work force with Modern Apprentices and Customer Service Advisors starting salaries between £17-£19 K.

Other employers signed up to attend including NHS Tayside, TESCO and many of the contractors from the new waterfront development who are about to begin recruiting for their new workforce.
