Orchestra is on at lunchtime today at 1.35pm in Music 3. See you all there! Miss Holbrook.

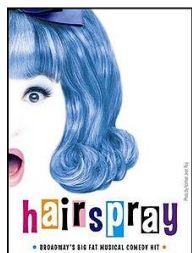
Assemblies w/b 26th February – 'Dundee Decides'
