All S2 pupils must bring their own container this week. You will be making soup in the department and HE have no soup containers left. A flask or plastic container with a tight fitting lid would be ideal.

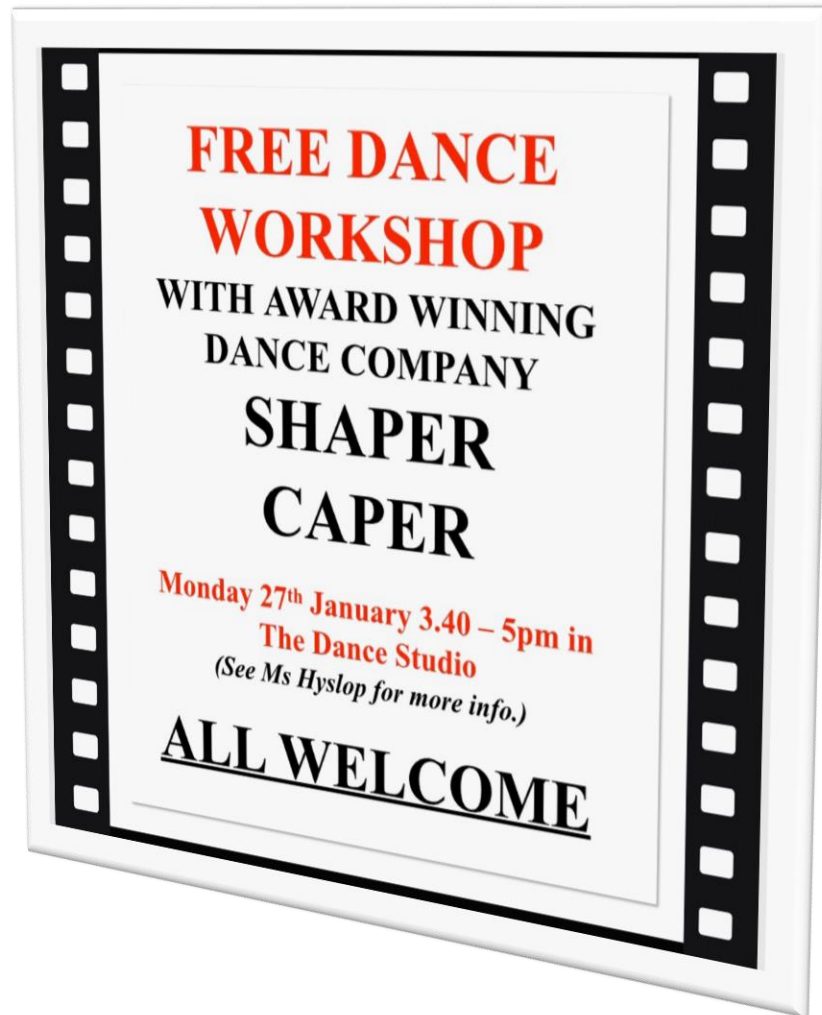
School Show 2020!
