

Term one - TONE- return the homeworks weekly to your teacher on the chosen day.

<p>Draw a solid object in pencil using tone, such as a bowl, a cup, an egg... The tone must be controlled and make the drawing look 3D.</p>	<p>Create a drawing of a natural object, for example, a pine cone or a leaf. You will do this using a black biro pen. You should include tone in this drawing using dots or cross-hatching to build up the shading</p>	<p>Draw a reflective object such as a spoon, a marble or a bottle... You should use pencil to complete this and include as much line and tone detail as you can.</p>
<p>You will attempt to copy the image of the Escher sphere, handed out by your class teacher. Try and copy the drawing as accurately as possible, including all shape, detail and tone.</p>	<p>In class you have been looking at portraiture. Using a mirror or a photograph you will create a detailed, close up drawing of an eye. Make it as detailed as you can.</p>	<p>Using an image you have taken or an image from the internet, draw an in depth portrait of someone you admire.</p>
